IACA Issues:

Training Options

Dana Boss did reach out to the private company offering training on AB109 but has not heard back yet.

Criminal Mindset and Tactics Post AB109 at FPD's Regional Training Center is scheduled for the same day as the monthly meeting, many members want to attend this training so the meeting will be moved to May 14th, possibly at Kaplan College in Clovis or Visalia at 10am for Cell Site Training with Calli Biaggi

CLETS/DMV/RAP Sheet training with Albert Loza discussed, the CLETS RAP Sheet training is limited to 50 people but it is unlimited for the DMV training. There is a lower cost for the CLETS training since the trainer comes from Sacramento, Tiffany Lauck-Reynolds offered Kingsburg as a possible location for the training and Erica Binford offered Clovis as an alternative location

The annual conference in San Diego will be September 1-4 at the Catamaran Resort Hotel and Spa. Presenters are still needed. Calli Biaggi advised that if your agency is reluctant to let you attend due to the lack of an agenda at this time, the state board can provide a tentative agenda, and also she can email some of the managers and tell them the importance of this training during the conference. Early registration fees thru March 31 are \$325, regular registration fees from 04/01 to 07/31 are \$375 and it goes up to \$400 from 08/01 to 09/01.

The state association will be sending letters all the agencies Chiefs and Sheriffs for nominations on the Analyst of the Year Awards
